3. Topics

◆ Efforts for "Bra Recycling"

Wacoal makes efforts for "Bra Recycling" as part of our environmental practice. This project asks our consumers to put their disused brassieres into our special collection bags and bring them to our shops for recycling.

A bra recycling project was planned in 2008 and implemented during February and April, 2010. A total of 800 shops, mainly Wacoal shops and underwear stores, including some departments and mass retailers, participated in this environmental practice.

The collected brassieres are recycled to industrial solid fuel called RPF and used as fuel for paper companies and other plants.

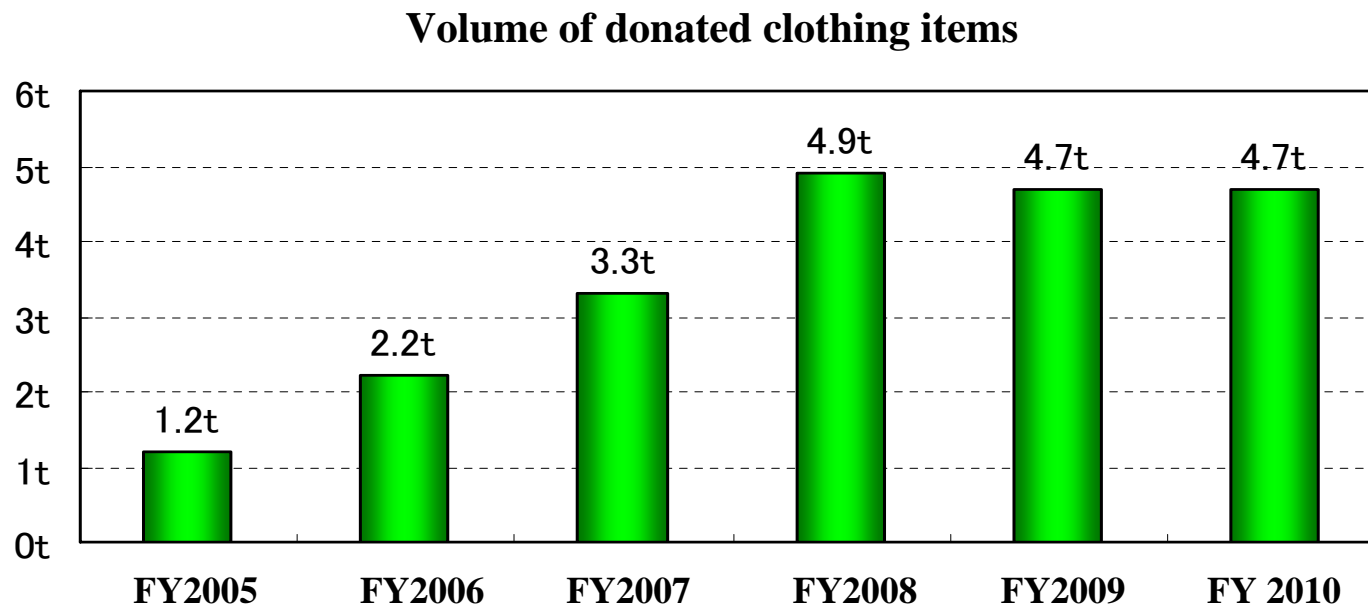
* Based on the total weight of the collected brassieres, the number of the bras was determined on the basis of 100g per brassiere.

We have continued to give our employees' unused personal clothing items to refugees and disaster victims through the Japan Relief Clothing Center since FY 2005.

Wacoal donated 4.7 tons of clothing items in FY 2010.

◆ Our environment-friendly products were exhibited for “Surprise! 100 Eco Ideas 2009”

An environmental event of “Surprise! 100 Eco Ideas” that was first held in Kyoto with a motto for “**More Ecological Ideas for More People**”.
